LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE PUNJAB COURT OF WARDS ACT, 1903, IN RELATION TO ESTATES OF RULERS OF INDIAN STATES.

S.R.O. 3289, dated the 19th October, 1954.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Himachal Pradesh shall exercise, in relation to estates, within the said State, of Rulers of Indian States, the powers and functions conferred on the Central Government by or under the Punjab Court of Wards Act, 1903 (Punjab Act II of 1903).
