

Please refer to your RTI application dated 05/03/2014 addressed to Central Public Information Officer, President's Secretariat, New Delhi, received by Ministry of External Affairs, RTI Cell on 19/03/2014 and received by this Division on 24/03/2014.

- 2. Point No. 1,2,9 &10 of your query do not come under the jurisdiction of this Division. The Point No. 1&2 are being forwarded to CPIC, Ministry of Defence. Point No.9 is being forwarded to CPIO, XP Division of MEA. Point No. 10 is being forward to CPIO, Ministry of Frome Affairs, for further necessary action. Point No.5& 6 are being forwarded to PAI Division, MEA for response regarding Pakistan.
- 3. The response to other points of your query is as follows -
- (i) Point No. 3 No specific archival information regarding the unilateral ceasefire declared by China in 1962 is available with this Division or CPIO.
- (ii) Point No.4 Since 1962 China has occupied approximately 38,000 sq km of territory in the Western Sector, of India- China boundary in the state of Jammu & Kashmir. Under the so-called China-Pakistan "Boundary Agreement" of 1963, Pakistan illegally ceded 5,180 sq km of territory in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir to China.

- Point No. 5, 6 During the Chinese Premier's visit to Fakistan in May 2013, the two sides agreed to jointly develop the Long-Term Plan for China-Pakistan Economic Cerridon. During the Pakistan Prints Minister's visit to China. in July 2513, the two sides agreed to set up a Joint Cooperation Committee on the Long- Term Plan for Onina- Paidstan Economic Comider. Ruada and other forms of connectivity envisaged in this Economic Corridor would pass through Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. Government is aware that Chine is executing infrastructure projects in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. Covernment has raised this issue with the Chinese side and has clearly conveyed India's consistent position that Pakistan has been in illegal occupation of parts of the Indian State of Jammu and Kashmir since 1947. China regards Kashmir as a bilateral matter to be settled between India and Pakistan. Government has conveyed its concerns to China about their activities in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir, and antiad them to cease such activities. Recentiky, during ther State Visit to India by Chiense premier in May 2013, both sides agriso fital, "The fitte sides will not allow their territories to be used for activities against the other. The two sides are committed to taking a positive view of and support each other's friendship with other countries." The full text of the joint Statement issued on this occasion is enclosed.
- During the visit of PM Shri Atal Bilitari Valpayee to Point No.7 (iv)China in June 2003, the two sides agreed to each appoint a Special Representative (SR) to explore from the political perspective of the overall bilateral relationship, the framework for a boundary settlement. This e have been seventeen roundes so far. The 15th round took place in New Delhi in January 2012, 16th round in Beijing in July 2013 and 17th round in New Dethi in February 2014. In January 2012, India and China signed an 'Agreement on the Establishment of a Working Mechanism on Consultation and Coordination (WMCC) on India-China Border Affairs'. The first meeting of the WMCC was held in March 2012 in Beijing , the second meeting was held in November 2012 in New Delhi, the 3rd meeting was held in New Delhi in JUly 2013, 4th meeting was held in Beijing in September 2013 and 5th meeting was held in New Delhi in February 2014. The press relewases regarding these meetings are enclosed. Besides WMCC nad diplomatic channels, other established mechanisms include border personnel meetings and flag meetings. More information is available on our website www.mea.gov.in
- (v) Point No.8 The issuance of visas by India and China is guided by the provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding on Simplifying Visa Procedures between the two governments signed in June 2003, which is being implemented by both sides. Government's position that there should be no discrimination against visa applicants of Indian nationality on grounds of domicile and ethnicity has been clearly conveyed to the Chinese Government on several occasions and at the highest level. Visas issued on a separate sheet of paper stapled to passports are not considered valid for travel out of the country.
