S.R.O. 545, dated the 28th February, 1955.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of the States of Tripura and Coorg shall, within their respective States, exercise the powers, and discharge the functions, of the State Government under the Plantations Labour Act, 1951 (LXIX of 1951).
