LIEUTENANT-GOVERNORS AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF PART C STATES TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE PETROLEUM CONCESSION RULES, 1949.

S.R.O. 955, dated the 29th April, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant-Governors or the Chief Commissioners of the respective Part C States shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Petroleum Concession Rules, 1949, within the limits of their respective States.
