CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF BHOPAL TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT ACT, 1952.



S.R.O. 1154, dated the 30th May, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control and until further orders, the Chief Commissioner of the State of Bhopal shall exercise the powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1952 (XLVI of 1952), in the State of Bhopal.
