CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF AJMER TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE AJMER ABOLITION OF INTERMEDIARIES AND LAND REFORMS ACT, 1955.

S.R.O. 1151, dated the 31st May, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control and until further orders, the Chief Commissioner, Ajmer, shall exercise the powers, and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Ajmer Abolition of Intermediaries and Land Reforms Act, 1955 (Ajmer Act No. III of 1955).
