1) Copy of the pension granted to the freedom fighters pension of the whole year 1980 to 2008 under Karnataka Quota. a) Whole list of application received from state of Karnataka; (b) Whole list of applicants rejected: (c) Whole list of the purpose on which the applicants rejected;	As per para 10 of the SSS Pension Scheme, 1980 the claim of the applicant will be scrutinized in the State Government / Union Territory administration in consultation with the State Advisory Committee on the basis of copy of application submitted to them. After receipt of State Verification and entitlement to pension report, the claim is scrutinized and if found eligible pension is granted. and as per applicable provisions of SSS Pension Scheme, 1980. On receipt of an application is examined on the basis of documents on records, mandatory entitlement to pension report from the State Government and applicable provisions of SSS Pension Scheme, 1980. The examination of the claim applications and decision thereon to accept or reject is a continuous process. There are no records pertaining to the total number of applications received and rejected.

(d) Whole list of application accepted and granted the pension under the freedom fighters Quota.	As per available record of this Ministry 10,100 persons from the State of Karnataka have been granted SSS Pension under SSS Pension Scheme, 1980.
