LIEUTENANT-GOVERNORS OF HIMACHAL PRADESH AND VINDHYA PRADESH AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF AJMER, BHOPAL, COORG, DELHI, KUTCH AND TRIPURA TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 133 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, 1908.

S.R.O. 1914, dated the 5th September, 1955.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control, the Lieutenant-Governor of each of the States of Himachal Pradesh and Vindhya Pradesh and the Chief Commissioner of each of the States of Ajmer, Bhopal, Coorg, Delhi, Kutch and Tripura, shall, in relation to the State concerned, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under the provisions of section 133 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (V of 1908).
