LIEUTENANT-GOVERNORS AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS TO EXERCISE POWERS  
AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE HINDU  
MARRIAGE ACT, 1955.

S.R.O. 2063, dated the 19th September, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 and clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control, the Lieutenant-Governor or Chief Commissioner, as the case may be, of a Part C State (including the Andaman and Nicobar Islands) shall, in relation to the State concerned, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (XXV of 1955).
