CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF BHOPAL TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 125 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, 1908.

S.R.O. 3394, dated the 31st October, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control, the Chief Commissioner of the State of Bhopal shall, in relation to the said State, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under section 125 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (V of 1908).
