CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF BHOPAL TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE WAKF ACT, 1954.



S.R.O. 128, dated the 12th January, 1956.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control and until further orders, the Chief Commissioner of the State of Bhopal shall, within the said State, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Wakf Act, 1954 (XXIX of 1954).
