CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF BHOPAL TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 198B (3) OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1898.

S.R.O. 267, dated the 2nd February, 1956.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Bhopal, shall, subject to the control of the President, and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the provisions of subsection (3) of section 198B of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (V of 1898), in the case of persons employed in connection with the affairs of the State of Bhopal.
