S.R.O. 446, dated the 15th February, 1956.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioners of the States of Tripura, Manipur, Kutch, Coorg, Ajmer and Delhi and Lt.-Governors of Himachal Pradesh and Vindhya Pradesh, shall, subject to the control of the President, and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 198B of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (V of 1898), in the case of persons employed in connection with the affairs of their respective States.
