S.R.O. 957, dated the 24th April, 1956.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 and clause (1) of article 243<sup>1</sup> of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control, the Lieutenant-Governor or Chief Commissioner, as the case may be, of a Part C State shall, in relation to the State concerned, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under clause (a) of section 2, and sections 15 and 16 of the Prize Competitions Act, 1955 (XLII of 1955).
