S.R.O. 2105, dated the 12th September, 1956.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the President hereby directs that the powers exercisable by the Central Government in respect of the appointment of the Mahant of Shri Jagannath Temple at Nahan will, until further orders, be exercisable by the Lieutenant-Governor of Himachal Pradesh.
