CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF DELHI TO DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE MINIMUM WAGES ACT, 1948, SO FAR AS THEY RELATE TO REVIEW AND REVISION OF MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR STONE BREAKING AND STONE CRUSHING LABOUR WORKING IN MINES AND QUARRIES.



S.R.O. 397, dated the 23rd January, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Delhi shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948), in so far as such functions relate to the review and revision of minimum rates of wages fixed under the said Act for employees, employed in stone breaking or stone crushing operations carried on in any mine and quarry situated within the Union territory of Delhi.
