NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. (128) .- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 87 of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966 (31 of 1966), the Central Government hereby extends to the Union territory of Chandigarh, the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Amendment Act, 1971 (Punjab Act No. 2 of 1971), as in force in the State of Punjab on the date of this notification, subject to the following modifications, namely :-

Modifications

1. In section 2, for the words, brackets and figures "the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954", the words, brackets and figures "the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954, as in force in the Union territory of Chandigarh" shall be substituted.
2. Section 3 shall be omitted.

THE PUNJAB ENTERTAINMENTS TAX (CINEMATOGRAPH SHOWS)
AMENDMENT ACT, 1971 (PUNJAB ACT NO. 2 OF 1971) AS EXTENDED
TO THE UNION TERRITORY OF CHANDIGARH.

An Act to amend the Punjab Entertainments Tax
(Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
Punjab in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as
follows :-

- Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Punjab Entertainments Tax
(Cinematograph Shows) Amendment Act, 1971.
- Amendment of 2. In sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Punjab
section 3 of Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954, as in force
Punjab Act in the Union territory of Chandigarh, for the word and figure
VIII of 1954. "Rs. 10" occurring between the words "not exceeding" and
