(128) .- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 87 of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1936 (31 of 1966), the Central Government hereby extends to the Union territory of Chandigarh, the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Amendment Act, 1971 (Punjab Act No. 2 of 1971), as in force in 'he State of Punjab on the date of this notification, subject to the following modifications, namely :-

Modifications

In section 2, for the words, brackets and figures "the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954", the words, brackets and figures "the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954, as in force in the Union territory of Chandigarh" shall be substituted.

Section 3 shall be omitted.

THE PUNJAB ENTER AINMENTS TAX (CINEMATOGRAPH SHOWS) AMENDMENT ACT, 1971 (PUNJAB ACT NO. 2 OF 1971) AS EXTENDED TO THE UNION TERRITORY OF CHANDIGARH.

An Act to amend the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

This Act may be called the Punjab Entertainments Tax Short title. (Cinematograph Shows) Amendment Act, 1971.

Amendment of section 3 of runjab Act VIIĬ of 1954.

In sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Punjab Entertainments Tax (Cinematograph Shows) Act, 1954, as in force in the Union territory of Chandigarh, for the word and figure "Rs. 10" occurring between the words "not exceeding" and "per show" the words "one hundred rupees" shall be substituted.
