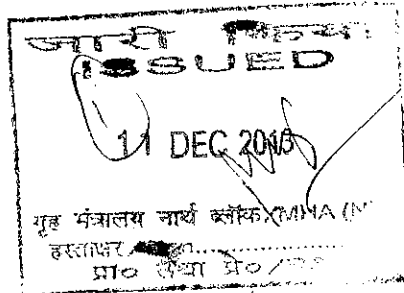

2. It is informed that Foreigners Division, MHA is concerned partly with point no. 1 and 9 of the RTI application. With reference to point no. 1 of the RTI application, it is stated that Foreigners Division, MHA has not made any reference to Ministry of External Affairs about trafficking victims who are foreign nationals and have been caught/rescued in Indian Territory as per prescribed performa. However, Point no. 1 of the RTI application may pertain to NE Division and CS Division, MHA. Therefore, point no 1 of the RTI application is transferred to NE Division and CS Division, MHA under section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005. Information in respect of point no. 9 will be sent separately.

3. The prescribed application fee under RTI Act, 2005 has been received in the Ministry of Home Affairs.

4. If you are not satisfied with the information given above, you may file an appeal with the Appellate Authority i.e Shri V. Vumlunmang, Joint Secretary (F), Ground Floor, NDCC Building, Jai Singh Road, New Delhi within the prescribed time limit.
