1.	The question is not clear. However, as regard the appointment of Administrator of a Union Territory, who is also sometimes designated as Lt. Governor, the appointment is made as per provision of Article 239 of the Constitution of India (a copy of the extract is enclosed). The copy of Constitution is also available on the official website of Government of India.
2.	As per Article 239 of the Constitution of India, President of India appoints the Administrator of a Union territory.
3.	The Administrator of a Union Territory is appointed as per provision of Article 239 of the Constitution of India. The proposal for appointment of Lt. Governor in the UTs of Puducherry, GNCTD and Andaman & Nicobar Islands are initiated by the Home Ministry and approval of the President of India is obtained through the Prime Minister's Office. Governor of Punjab acts as Administrator of Chandigarh as well. Administrators in the UTs of Lakshadweep and DD&DNH are appointed from the serving AGMU cadre IAS officers of super time scale.
4.	The proposal for appointment of Administrator/Lt. Governor in the UTs is initiated by the Home Ministry and approval of the President of India is obtained through the Prime Minister of India.

6.	People other than belonging to IAS can be appointed as Administrator of UT except for DD&DNH and Lakshadweep, where usually IAS officers are posted. There are no codified guidelines in this regard.
