

The Applicant/appellant respectfully submits as, under:

Appellant has filed the RTI Application dated 01.11.2013 (Copy enclosed as Annexure-A) and subsequently, application was transferred with various quarters and thereafter, received on 12.12.2013 letter/reply dated 20.12.2013 whereby, application was transferred with Director (S-II), Ministry of Home Affairs, to provide the information (Copy enclosed as Annexure-B).

However, thereafter, neither information nor any intimation was received although mandatory period to provide the information was already over on 28.12.2013 therefore, appellant is constrained to file the present First Appeal accordingly filing the same on the following grounds, as under;

Grounds:

That according to Section 7 (1) of the RTI Act 2005, the CPIO was required to provide the information within 'thirty days' whereas, in the present case, information was still not provided, which attracts Section 20 (1) of the RTI Act 2005 consequently, appellant request your authority, to look into the matter and direct the CPIO to provide information, forthwith.
