

Also provide reasons to stop that legislation/bill. Were those legislation/bill ultimately introduced in Delhi Assembly, and were those legislation/bill passed in Delhi Assembly. If Yes then please provide details as on which dates those were passed and by how many votes in favor and against and which political party and/or member legislative assembly (MLA) opposed and favored that legislation/bill.

3. Can a MLA of any legislative assembly on the floor of the house (while assembly is in session) introduce a legislation/bill impromptu for debate and resolution. If not then does it violate any constitutional rights of the elected member being representative of the people of

If yes then give details of all those legislation/bill as on which date these were introduced, in which legislative assembly it was introduced, which MLA introduced (please mention his political party, if applicable), what was the description of legislation/bill, what were deliberations on the floor of the house on record, when was decision taken, how many were in favor of it and how many were against it, which political party and/or member legislative assembly (MLA) opposed and favored that legislation/bill.

4. Had any MLA of any legislative assembly been debarred from the assembly because of his/her misconduct any time in the past. Who were those MLAs, please give their names, which political parties they belonged, what were the reasons to debar them. Did Speaker take a decision in this regard or a special committee was formed for the said purpose. If a special committee was formed then who were the members and please provide minutes of all their meetings for the said purpose. Was their findings placed before the house for deliberations and decisions. If yes, then what was the decision taken. Was it implemented and if the MLA was debarred, from which date to which date he/she was debarred.
