
2. PMI to UN has requested to nominate an officer from Member States that currently have FPUs deployed in United Nations field missions, as well as those from Member States that have pledged FPUs to participate in the workshop scheduled to take place from 23 to 27 March 2026 at the Centre of Excellence for Stability Police Units (CoESPU), Vicenza, Italy.

3. These workshops aim to foster a common understanding of how to address performance-related issues, FPU generation mechanism, pre-deployment training, and COE issues, as well as to review recent changes in key guiding documents such as the revised FPU Policy, PCRS Guidelines, COE Manual, among others.

4. Centre of Excellence for Stability Police Units (CoESPU) will cover full-board accommodation and meals, while travel expenses for the nominated participants are to be borne by the Police Contributing Countries (PCC). All the other related expenses including travel will be covered by the nominating Department/Force.

5. It is requested to nominate 01 suitable officer of the rank of Commandant for the said workshop to this Ministry latest by 09.01.2026. While forwarding the nomination, the department may ensure to forward the duly completed and signed Bio-data in prescribed proforma (enclosed) and HR certificate along with the recommendation of Head of the Force including APAR/ACR gradings for the Last Five Years (Mandatory) of the nominated officer in a single PDF only through email at police2-un@mha.gov.in.
