

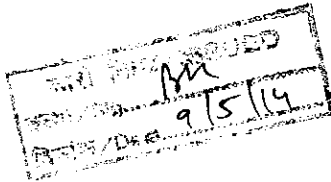

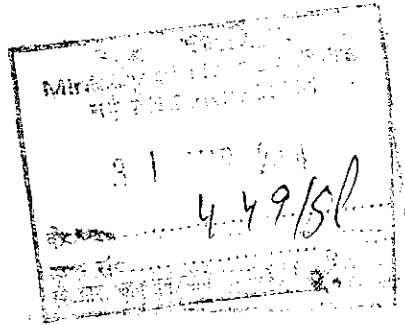

Subject: -Pay Fixation upon promotion to IPS as per IPS (Pay Rules)- 2007.

Sir,

It is submitted that I was promoted to IPS on the basis of Select List-2010 by MHA notification No. 1-14011/14/2011-IPS.I (II).Government of India/Bharat Sarkar dated_16/12/2011. My pay was fixed by Delhi Police in terms of DOPT's notification dated 03.03.2010 and **vide order No.14016/20/2011-UTS-II Government of India Ministry of Home Affairs dated 19.07.2012 in Pay Band -IV (37400-67000 Grade Pay 8700)** (Copy enclosed).

Now my pay has been again fixed by MHA in PB-3 i.e.Rs. 15600 – 39100with grade pay of Rs. 7600/- vide Order No.F.No. 14016/35/2013.UTS-I, Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs. dated 24th April 2014.(Copy enclosed).

It is important to point out that the initial fixation of Pay of State Police Officers promoted to IPS is governed by IPS (Pay Rules)-2007 amended from time to time. As per Rule 5(3) the initial pay of State Police Officer on his appointment to IPS is to be fixed as the Principles laid down in Schedule-I. Para (1) of Schedule-I of the said Rule (as amended vide GSR-172 (E), dated 3rd March-2010) provides as under:-

“(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the first proviso to sub-rule(1) of rule 3, and the Notes thereunder, the initial pay of a promoted officer or an officer appointed by selection, as the case may, shall be fixed in the Pay Band 3 or pay band 4 by adding one increment equal to 3% of the sum of the pay in the pay band and the grade pay applicable which will be rounded off to the next multiple of 10 and in addition, the grade pay of Senior Time Scale or Junior Administrative Grade or Selection Grade, corresponding to pay scale or grade pay in the State Service, shall be granted.


Provided that the grade pay attached to Selection Grade shall be granted with the pay in running pay band-4 only”

The pay of the applicant was to be fixed by MHA in terms of above mentioned provisions. At the time of my promotion I was drawing pay in PB-4 i.e. Rs. 37400-67000 with Grade Pay Rs. 8700/- in DANIPS. Hence the pay of the applicant was to be fixed in PB-4 i.e. Rs. 37400-67000 with Grade Pay Rs. 8700/- i.e. Selection Grade Scale of IPS in terms of Para(1) Schedule I read with Rule 5(3) of IPS (Pay Rules)-2007. Government of Goa, Directorate of Accounts vide its order No. DA/PA-VII/U-I/2012-2013/1509 dated 8th Oct in terms of DOPT's notification dated 03.03.2010 had fixed the applicants pay scale correctly by granting Pay Scale of PB-4 with GP Rs. 8700/- which were in accordance with Amended IPS (Pay Rules)-2007.

From the above facts it is evident that the pay fixation of the applicant in PB-3 i.e. Rs. 15600 - 39100 with grade pay of Rs. 7600/- vide order No. F.No. 14016/35/2013.UTS-I, Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs dated 24th April 2014 is incorrect and not as per rule provisions in this regard.

It is, therefore, requested that a fresh pay fixation order may kindly be issued by placing the applicant in PB-4 i.e. Rs. 37400-67000 with Grade Pay Rs. 8700/- in terms of above mentioned provisions of IPS (Pay Rules)-2007.
