LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH, CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, TRIPURA, MANIPUR AND ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS AND ADMINISTRATOR OF LACCADIVE, MINICOY AND AMINDIVI ISLANDS, TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERN-MENT UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLES ACT, 1939.

S. R. O. 1394, dated the 26th April, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant-Governor of Himachal Pradesh, Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Tripura, Manipur and Andaman and Nicobar Islands, and the Administrator, Laccadive, Minicoy and Amindivi Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (4 of 1939) within their respective territories.
