R. O. 685, dated the 12th February, 1954, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of the Union territory of Delhi and the Lieutenant-Governor of the Union territory of Himachal Pradesh shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the appropriate Government under section 8 of the Employees' Provident Funds Act, 1952 (19 of 1952), within their respective territories.
