

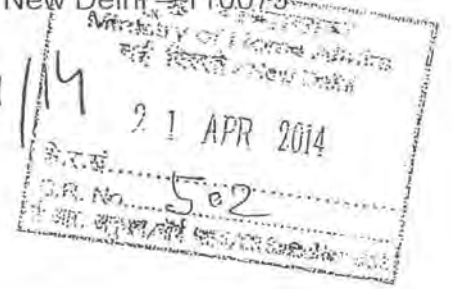

(d) When this proposal was officially forwarded to Cabinet Secretary? Please provide copy of covering letter.

(e) When MHA (Ministry of Home Affairs) was informed by Govt of India (Cabinet Secretariat) about acceptance of proposal by Govt of India & inclusion of various departments of MHA in second schedule?

(f) How many organizations were initially proposed to be included in second schedule and finally how many were approved by Govt of India? Kindly provide the list.

(g) Please confirm if any meeting took place in MHA to discuss this issue and minutes were recorded? If yes, kindly provide copy of minutes.
