

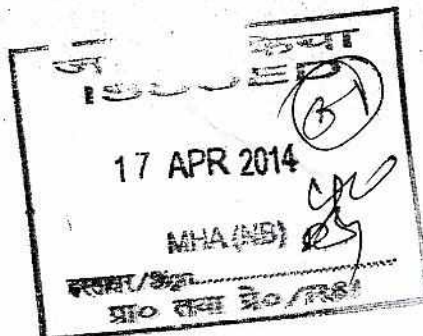

1. Name of the Examination :

Assistant Commandant Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for GD Cadre in the CPOs.

2. Duration :

Assistant Commandant (GD) Limited Departmental Competitive Examination will be held separately by all the CPOs once every year.

3. Eligibility Conditions :

Both Sub-Inspectors (GD) & Inspectors (GD) will be eligible to appear in the said LDCE.

(a) Service eligibility : They should have completed four years of service including training.

(b) Upper age & : The upper age limit for appearing in the LDCE will be thirty five (35) years. The required educational Educational Qualifications qualification will be graduation which is also the eligibility for DR Assistant Commandants.

(c) Clean Record

(d) Physical Standards: As applicable to Assistant Commandant (DE) candidates standards.

4. Number of chances admissible :

In all, three chances will be given for appearing in the LDCE.

5. Agency, syllabi & procedure :

The examination will be conducted by the individual forces and will consist of written and physical tests.

The syllabi will be decided by the individual forces in consultation with BPR&D. Written paper for Assistant Commandants (Direct Recruitment) can be taken as a model.

6. Distribution of Vacancies :

The distribution of vacancies at Assistant Commandant (GD) level for LDCE will be as follows :-

1. Direct Recruitment : 50% (including Ex-SSCOs quota & in case of CISF also including optee quota).
2. Promotion Quota : 33%
3. LDCE : 17%

The unfilled vacancies in the LDCE for the year will go to the promotion quota and will not be carried forward.

7. Training :

The selected Assistant Commandants through the LDCE will undergo separate training of Assistant Commandants and will be on probation for 2 years.

8. Relaxation :

The relaxation for SC/ST & OBC candidates will be admissible as per Govt. Rules.

9. Seniority :

The personnel recruited through Ltd. Departmental Competitive Examination will be treated as part of promotions quota and their seniority will be with reference to the date of selection as per DOP&T's OM NO. 22011/5/76-Estt.'D' dated 24.6.78. Within the candidates selected through LDCE the inter-se-seniority will be as per their position in the merit list of LDCE.




