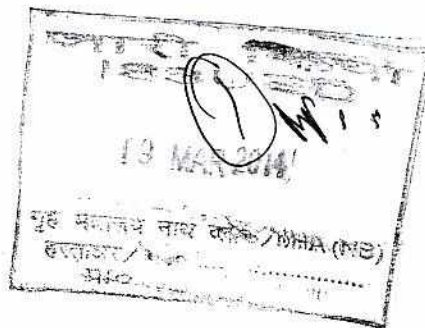

Subject: AC (LDCE) in CAPFs for the year 2012-13 – reg.

CRPF may please refer to their UO Note No A.VI-1/2012-13-Rectt (SSB) dated 30th Dec 2013 requesting the members of the Interview Board to sign the board proceedings.

2. It has been observed that as per the procedure adopted by CRPF, who were the Nodal Agency for conducting the examination, the role of MHA members was confined to only assess whether candidate got any Gallantry medal or other citation during his service and give marks out of a maximum of five. As such the role of the MHA representative had been severally curtailed having virtually no say in the interview process.

3. The interviews conducted by CRPF are violative of the procedure laid down in SOP as the composition of Interview Board laid down in Para 6.3 of the SOP for selection of AC(GD) through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination clearly states that representative of MHA will be the Member of the board and it is obvious that he will have full participation in assessing the candidates being judged in the interview. In the SOP, it is nowhere laid down that the representative of MHA will not assess all the aspects of a candidate being judged in the interview.

4. CRPF are, therefore, requested that interviews for AC LDCE 2012-13 may be re-conducted in which MHA representative be given full participation and give assessment of the candidate out of total marks of 100 alongwith other board members.

MHA issued SOP dated 23.11.2005 providing detailed guidelines for conducting LDCE for promotion to the rank of AC (GD) to the extent of 17% of vacancies. As per scheme the appointment through the AC (LDCE) is the part of promotion quota. Sub Inspector (GD) and Inspector (GD) who have completed 04 years of service including training period, and are below 35 years of age with graduation are eligible to appear in the said exam. The LDCE comprises (i) Written test (three papers), (ii) Physical efficiency test, (iii) Interview and Personality test (iv) Medical Examination.

2. As per the composition of interview board indicated in the SOP, one member is of the rank of Director/DS/US from MHA. It is pointed out that in all DPCs, LDCE conducted in attached offices is represented by the Ministry through nominating an officer of the Ministry. This representation of the Ministry is to enhance transparency, impartiality and proper monitoring.
3. The interviews for the post of Assistant Commandants (GD) in CAPFs through Limited Departmental Competitive Examinations were held w.e.f. 5th November, 2013 to 14th November, 2013. MHA had nominated six officers as member of the board on different days.

Total no. of candidates appeared for interview are **281** and total marks for the interview are **100**.

However, as per the procedure adopted by the CRPF, who were the Nodal Agency for conducting the examination, the role of MHA members was confined to only assess whether candidate got any Gallantry medal or other citation during his service and give marks out of a maximum of five.

4. Officers of Under Secretary/Deputy Secretary level were nominated on this interview board. The post of Assistant Commandant is the Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/-, while the officers representing MHA were in the higher Grade Pay of Rs.6600/7600. Thus, they were in higher grade pay then the post for which interview was being conducted and they were competent to judge all aspects being tested in the interview and have equal-say.

5. The interviews for the first seven days were attended by the Under Secretaries of MHA, who signed the sheets limited to awarding of maximum of five marks for any gallantry medal or other citation to the candidate. DS(Pers1) attended the interview on the last day on 14th Nov., 2013 therein it was seen


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that the role of MHA representative had been severally curtailed having virtually no say in the interview process.

This was pointed out to the concerned officers. After returning to MHA the matter was further discussed and CRPF was asked to conduct the interview afresh.

6. However, instead of doing so a communication has been received from the office of Chairman, Interview Board that the Representatives of MHA should appear in his office for signing the proceedings of interviews on 07.01.2014, which may be seen as an attempt to pressurize MHA into agreeing/course of action totally ultra vires.

7. The interviews conducted by CRPF are violative of the procedure laid down in SOP as the composition of Interview Board laid down in Para 6.3 of the SOP for selection of AC(GD) through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination clearly states that representative of MHA will be the Member of the board and it is nowhere laid down that he will not assess all the aspects of a candidate being judged in the interview. CRPF may accordingly be advised that the interviews for AC LDCE 2012-13 are to be re-conducted in which MHA representative be given full participation and give assessment of the candidate out of total marks of 100 along with other board members.




