

8	What all benefits we can avail from Central Govt. and different state Govt. as CAPF ex-servicemen.	In accordance with above OM, the State/UT Governments are at liberty to extend benefits to Ex-CAPF personnel at par with Ex-Servicemen of Defence Forces personnel. However, as on date Goa (State), Daman & Diu and Dadar & Nagar Haveli have issued notification to extend the benefits as available to the Ex-Servicemen to all retired Central Armed Police Force Personnel (Ex-CAPF personnel) of their States.
9	Is there any State or PSU providing rehabilitation as ex-servicemen after retirement on any other job?	
10	Why central CPC canteens are not at par with the CSD canteens. What all steps you are going to take improve the facility.	It is informed that as per Section-2 (j) of RTI Act, 2005, "right to information" means the right to information accessible under the Act which is held by or under the control of any public authority. Further, the Central Information Commission also vide its order dated 10/05/2007 in the appeal No. 452/ICPB/2006 held that as per RTI Act, a citizen can seek only information which is available with the public authority in material form. The public authority is not bound to answer queries like <b>why and what</b> and under what circumstances to the applicant. In view of the above, information sought by you do not fall in the ambit of RTI Act, 2005.

3. In case you are not satisfied with the reply, the appeal in the case lies with Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Joint Secretary (P-II), Room No. 171-B, MHA, North Block, New Delhi-01. The appeal may be filed within 30 days from the date of receipt of this reply.

Subj: Grant of Risk/Hardship based allowances to CPMFs personnel as per the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission - regarding

In pursuance of Government's decision on the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission conveyed vide para-9 of resolution No. 171/2008-IC dated 29<sup>th</sup> Aug 2008, the President is pleased to convey approval for introduction of the following risk/hardship based allowances to combatized CPMFs personnel upto the rank of Commandant :-

(a) High Altitude Allowance

High Altitude Allowance at the same rates as admissible to Army personnel when deployed in areas:-

- (i) With altitude between 9000 ft. to 15000 ft. and above 15000 ft;
- (ii) Co-located in the areas specified by Army under Category-II and uncongenial areas below the height of 9000 ft. under Category-I.
- (iii) Other uncongenial areas not covered under Army specified locations would be considered by the Committee under AS&FA(Home) on case-to-case basis.

(b) CPMFs personnel deployed under Ops control of Army or in areas/co-ordinates defined by Army but not under Ops control.

- (i) CPMF personnel deployed in areas/co-ordinates defined by Army either under Ops control or otherwise would be entitled to the Field Area Allowances or the Counter Insurgency Operations (CI Ops) Allowance admissible to personnel of the Army, at the same rates, as admissible to Army personnel in the areas of deployment;
- (ii) CPMFs deployments in extremely difficult areas along the border and other such areas not falling under the areas/co-ordinates defined by Army shall be considered by the Committee under AS&FA(Home) based on degree of hardship and merits of each case.

(c) CPMF personnel deployed in areas affected by Left Wing Extremism (LWE)

- (i) Personnel of the CPMFs deployed (strictly operational strength) for specified Anti Naxal Operations in LWE affected areas on specific notification/orders of Ministry of Home Affairs would be entitled to LWE risk allowance at rates equivalent to CI Ops in Modified Field Area Allowance admissible to Army;
- (ii) CPMF Bns/Coys deployed for counter insurgency operations in J&K and NE Areas not covered by areas/co-ordinates defined by Army will be considered on case to case basis by the Committee under AS&FA(Home) on furnishing of deployment details with adequate justification by the CPMFs;
- (iii) CPMFs personnel, upto the rank of Commandant, on deputation to the Commando Battalion for Resolute Action (CoBRA) of CRPF would be entitled to an allowance at the rate of 80% of Marine Commandos (MARCOS) Allowance.

In addition the following deployments shall also be entitled to risk/hardship based allowances at the rates indicated against each category :-

- (a) CPMFs personnel deployed in the BOPs of the Rann of Kutch area of Gujarat and the Sunderban area of West Bengal would be entitled to Modified Field Area Allowance admissible to Army personnel deployed in areas classified as Modified Field Areas by the Army. In addition, such CPMF personnel would be entitled to an allowance as applicable to Uncongenial Areas (below 9000 ft.) at the rates of the High Altitude Allowance Category (1) of the Army as provided.
- (b) CPMF personnel deployed in all air maintained BOPs would also be entitled to an allowance as applicable Uncongenial Areas (below 9000 ft.). This will be in addition to any category of Field Area Allowance which they may be also entitled to. In case an air maintained BOP does not qualify for any Field Area Allowance, then CPMF personnel deployed in such BOPs would be entitled to the Modified Field Area Allowance in addition to High Altitude Category-I allowance as applicable for Uncongenial Areas (below 9000 ft.).


The risk/hardship allowances proposed shall be admissible to combatized CPMFs personnel. The terms and conditions governing Army Allowances shall also apply to CPMF personnel.

CPMF personnel shall have the option to receiving their existing package of compensatory allowances and detachment allowance, or the risk/hardship allowances proposed at para-1 and 2 above, whichever is beneficial to them.

Given the dynamic internal security scenario, the Committee under AS&FA(Home) notified vide this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2008 shall periodically review the categorization/classification of locations, with at least one annual review, and recommend additions/deletions/changes in classification of locations, if any.

These orders will be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2009.



**Sub: Grant of Risk/Hardship based allowances to CAPFs personnel as per the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission – regarding.**

The undersigned has been directed to convey, in continuation of MHA letter No. II-27012/56/2008-PF.I dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2009 that the Government has approved grant of risk/hardship allowances equal to CI Operation in Field Area Allowance in the place of existing Modified Field Area Allowance for CAPFs personnel deployed in 35 focused districts in LWE areas identified by MHA as most hardship prone. Other districts in LWE areas would continue to be entitled to CI Ops in Modified Field Area Allowance. The number of districts may change depending on MHA notification on classifying/declassifying these districts as hardship prone area in LWE States. The 35 focused districts where Field Area Allowance is sanctioned are as follows:

Sub : Grant of Risk/Hardship based allowances to CPMFs personnel as per the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission - regarding

This is in-continuation of this Ministry's O.M. No. II-27012/56/2008-PF.I dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2009, the proposal of ITBP for considering HAUCA-III to the force personnel deployed at High Altitude and uncongenial areas have been considered in consultation with Ministry of Finance (DoE). The force personnel who are deployed in these locations and not covered under Army specified locations for HAUCA-III can be given the allowance on the basis of altitude criteria as laid down in MHA's O.M. No. II-27012/56/2008-PF.I dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2009.

2. As far as those locations, which do not meet the altitude criteria are concerned, extension of the uncongenial area allowance can be considered on a case to case basis and after examining the justifications in detail and also after comparing with the allowances available to the Army in these areas.



Sub: Detachment Allowance to CPMF personnel as per the recommendations of 6<sup>th</sup> CPC - regarding.

Consequent upon the implementation of the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission, the President is pleased to decide the daily rates given in Annexure, for calculation of Detachment Allowance, without any linkage to the revised rates of TA/DA recommended by 6<sup>th</sup> CPC. The payment of Detachment Allowance to the CPMFs' personnel shall be regulated in terms of Rule 46(c) of CRPF Rules 1956, read with SR 71 and 73. The extant terms and conditions governing payment of Detachment Allowance shall remain unchanged.

2. The daily rates will be increased by 25% every time the Dearness Allowance payable on revised pay scales goes up by 50%.

3. The revised rates of Detachment Allowance shall be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008.

Renewal Grant	Rs.1500/- for group "A" officers and Rs.500/- for group "B" officers	Rs.3000/- for all categories of personnel. Renewal grant to be granted after every 7 years.
Kit Maintenance Allowance	Rs.80/- p.m. for group "A" officers Rs.40/- p.m. for group "B" officers	Rs.150 p.m. for group "A" officers Rs.75 p.m. for group "B" officers
Washing Allowance	Non-gazetted staff @ Rs.5/- p.m. in addition to supply of washing soap at fixed intervals.	Rs.30/- p.m. for non-gazetted staff subject to discontinuance of washing soap.
