Subject: - **Appeal under Right to Information Act, 2005 – regarding.**

Reference is invited to appeal dated 24.07.2014 filed by Shri B.Surendran for providing information sought by him vide RTI application dated 09.06.2014.

2. The undersigned has gone through the case and it has been noted that the aforesaid RTI application dated 09.06.2014 was transferred under Section 6(3) of RTI, Act, 2005 to the CPIOs of CAPFs & AR vide this Ministry's letter of even No.I.45020/01/2014-Pers.II dated 03.07.2014, for giving a reply directly to the applicant, as the requisite action was falling in the domain of CAPFs & AR.

3. The applicant has now made the instant appeal in which he has stated that all the CAPFs, except BSF and AR, have given a reply all in denial enjoying excuse under the provisio of Section 24(1) of the RTI, Act, 2005 and requested to ask the appropriate authorities to provide him the requisite information. In this regard, it is informed that the CPIOs of CRPF, BSF, CISF, ITBP, SSB & AR have sent a reply to him on 09.07.2014, 22.07.2014, 08.07.2014, 18.07.2014, 16.07.2014 & 22.07.2014 respectively. A copy each of reply sent by CAPFs & AR is enclosed for ready reference.

4. Since, the CPIOs of all CAPFs including BSF & AR have already sent a reply to the applicant, no action seems to be pending at this stage. However, the applicant may file appeal with the 1st Appellate Authority of CAPFs & AR, if he is not satisfied with the reply furnished by the CPIOs of CAPFs & AR. The appeal is disposed off accordingly.

2. After careful consideration of your application on the subject, it is intimated that as per Section- 24 (1) of Right to Information Act, 2005, Central Police Forces as listed in the Second Schedule of the Act, have been given qualified exemption from the Act in so far as the allegations of other than those connected with Human Right Violations and Corruption are concerned. From the facts of the case mentioned in your application cited above, there appears to be no violations of Human Rights as well as facts of the case do not attract the allegations of corruption. Moreover, there is no public interest to disclose such information. Hence, this department is not liable to provide the information sought by you.

3. If you are not satisfied with this reply, you may prefer an appeal under section 19 of the RTI Act-2005 to the IGP(Adm), Appellate authority, Dte. Genl, CRPF, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi within 30 days from its receipt.






