Whereas the petitioner had submitted a RTI application dated 09.03.2014 addressed to the CPIO, Ministry of Home affairs seeking the information under the Right to Information Act, 2005.


2. Earlier the applicant had sought the information regarding recruitment, appointment process and criteria of promotion from DIG to IG rank in BSF.

3. Whereas Director (Pers) and CPIO informed the petitioner that the information was not available with him and it might be available with the BSF and the RTI request was accordingly transferred to CPIO, BSF on 01.4.2014 (copy attached).

4. Whereas the petitioner has now submitted his first appeal dated 18.4.2014 to the undersigned stating that he has not received any reply against his RTI application dated 09.3.2014.

5. I have gone through the appeal filed by the applicant. I have also gone through the RTI application dated 09.03.2014 filed by the applicant. I find that the information sought by the applicant is concerned with BSF. Therefore, the RTI application dated 09.03.2014 has rightly been transferred by Director (Pers) and CPIO to the CPIO, BSF for disposal under RTI Act. The applicant should have submitted his first Appeal to the first Appellate Authority of BSF. Appeal is therefore, transferred to the Appellate Authority of BSF for disposal under RTI Act.

6. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

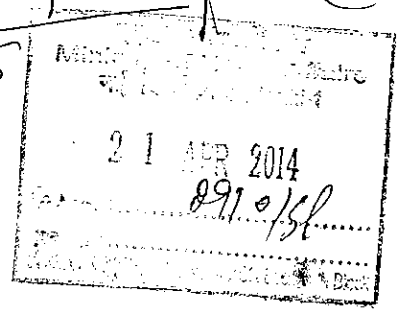

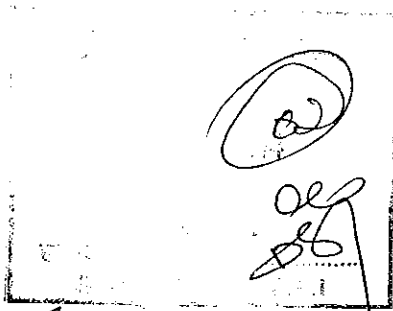

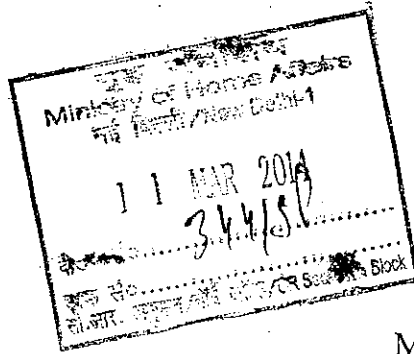
