Sir,

Please refer to your RTI application dated 05.05.2014 received in this unit on transfer on 21.05.2014.

2. In this regard, the point-wise reply is as under:

- (i) It is stated that number of categorized protectees varies from time to time based on reviews carried out taking into account the threat assessment made by the Central Security Agencies. However, as on date, there are 230 number of categorized protectee in the Central list. Further details with regard to details of the protectees, including politicians, who have been provided security cannot be disclosed as the same are exempt under Sections 8(1)(g) and 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act-2005. However, the information sought by you may also be related to Delhi Police and State Government concerned. A copy of your application is being transferred under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act-2005 to Delhi Police for providing requisite information to you directly. As regards information related to State Government protectees, you may contact the PIO of State Government concerned to obtain the requisite information directly under the RTI Act-2005.
- (ii) The responsibility of providing security to an individual is primarily that of the State Government concerned in whose jurisdiction such individual is ordinarily resident or happens to be. Security is generally provided on the basis of assessment of threat carried out by the security agencies. Due to involvement of multiple agencies including State Government agencies in providing security cover, it is difficult to calculate the actual expenditure incurred on providing security cover and such details are not maintained in this office.

(iii) As already stated security cover is provided on the basis of assessment of threat carried out by the security agencies concerned irrespective of his/her background.

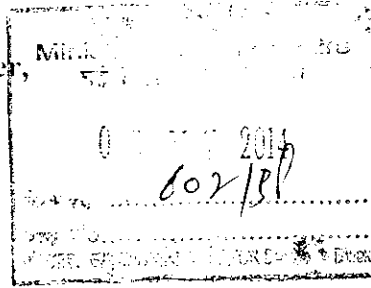
