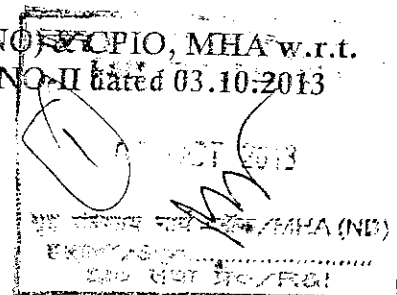

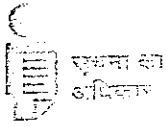


Subject: Right to Information Act, 2005 - compliance of the provisions of RTI Act, 2005 regarding.

The Right to Information Act, 2005 seeks to promote a culture of openness and transparency in the working of the Government. The Central Public Information Officers (CPIOs) of a public authority play an important role in the effective implementation of the provisions of the said Act.

2. It has, however, come to notice from the members of public that some of the applications have not been replied within the stipulated time. The CPIOs are required to provide information to the applicant within thirty days of the receipt of a valid application. If the information sought for concerns the life or liberty of a person, the information shall be provided within forty-eight hours of the receipt of the request. Therefore, all CPIOs in this Ministry are hereby advised to comply with the provisions contained in the RTI Act, 2005 and provide information or transfer applications under Section 6 (3) within the period prescribed under the Act.
