





- (a) whether cases of smuggling of milch cattle from various parts of the country have come to the notice of the Government;
- (b) if so, the details of such cases reported during the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (c) the measures taken by the Government to check such illegal activities?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

(a)&(b) Instances of seizure of milch cattle have been reported along Indo-Bangladesh Border. The details of total cattle and milch cattle seized on Indo-Bangladesh Border during the last three years including the current year are as under:

Instances of smuggling of milch cattle along Indo-Nepel as well as Indu-Rhoten borders are very common since these borders remain open, porous and visa-free.

- c) The following effective measures have been taken by the Government to check illegal activities including smuggling of cattle:-
- (i) Vulnerability mapping of the Border Out Posts (BOPs)/areas along Indo-Bangladesh Border which are sensitive with regard to cattle smuggling is being reviewed periodically. Presently, 33 BOPs vulnerable to cattle smuggling have been identified and strengthened by deploying additional man power, Special Surveillance Equipments, vehicles and other infrastructure in support.
- (ii) Increase in number of Simultaneous Co-ordinated Patrolling (SCPs) with counterpart during the sent high.
- (iii) Effective domination of the border by carrying out form: -C a-risotraurveliance of the borders, vis., permitting, taying maken, establishing of characters of all event the International Conference and strongthening of existing defence of the BOSs.
- (iv) Erection of Border Policing on the International Borden
