2. How often (monthly, quarterly or yearly) does the above mentioned committee meets ?
3. How many such religious and educational institutions have been identified so far, year-wise breakup?
4. What action has been taken against such institutions?
5. What is the monitoring mechanism of the committee?
6. How much money or financial support these institutions have received so far?
7. Has the matter been taken up at diplomatic levels with Nepal and Bangladesh? If yes, what are the minutes of the meeting?
8. Does the proliferation of these religious institutions a threat to national security?
9. Who are the frontpersons or front-organisations of these religious institutions in India ?
