During a detailed review of border works along Indo-Bangladesh border on 5.1.2011, the construction agencies have informed that border works in Lunglei district are progressing without any hindrance or local protest. This has been possible due to your kind intervention. Thank you.

However, CMD, EPIL informed that the construction agency is not in a position to take up construction activities (border fencing and road) over 4.105 km in 7 stretches since the land involved has not been vacated by the dwellers despite, payment of cost of land by EPIL. Reportedly, the District Administration has also disbursed the same to the claimants. The details of these stretches are as under-


