With reference to points No. 2 and 4 of your RTI application dated 24.06.2014 and the Ministry of Home Affairs OM No. A-43020/01/2014-RTI dated 01.07.2014 on the subject mentioned above, the following information is provided:

Point	Reply
2	This Ministry is only administratively concerned with the President's Emoluments and Pension Act, 1951 and the rules made thereunder. The papers relating to pension in respect of ex-Presidents are being processed by the President's Secretariat. Hence, your application is being transferred to the President's Secretariat for further necessary action.
4	The Governors (Emoluments, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1982 and the Governors (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1987 lay down the privileges of the Governors in the matter of their emoluments, facilities, etc. Under these, there is no provision for pension to ex- Governors. This CPIO does not have any information relating to the pension Shri B.L. Joshi gets as an ex-Police Officer.

2. As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, an appeal against this letter would lie before Shri S. Suresh Kumar, Joint Secretary (CS) and the First Appellate Authority, Ministry of Home Affairs, NDCC-II Building, Jai Singh Road, New Delhi.

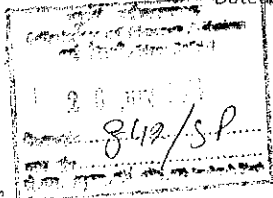
