4. Names of staff/lawyers arranged by members/s of JS Verma Commission mentioning also details of payments if made to such staff/lawyers etc arranged by members/s of JS Verma Commission either by Union government and/or by member/s of JS Verma Commission
5. Complete information on rules providing JS Verma Commission to seek assistance of private staffers arranged by members of the Commission
6. Complete information on pay, perks, facilities etc provided to members of JS Verma Commission
7. Is it true that a web-link was first provided and then removed from MHA website to upload JS Verma Commission report as also referred in enclosed news-clipping?
8. Complete information together with related file-notings/correspondence/documents on first providing and then removing a web-link from MHA website to upload JS Verma Commission report as also referred in enclosed news-clipping
9. Complete information on uploading JS Verma Commission report on website mentioning web-link if already uploaded
10. Complete information on source of easy availability of JS verma Commission report through PDF-files on internet if it was not officially uploaded
11. Number of copies of JS Verma committee prepared mentioning details of copies provided to different authorities

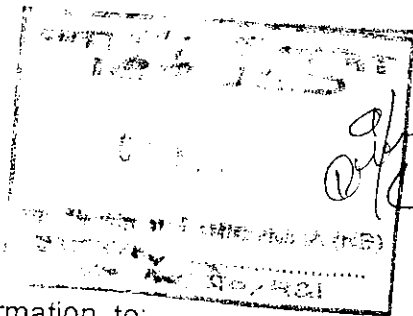
