

Please refer to your two similar RTI applications dated 16-11-2013 and 18-11-2013 which were transferred to Ministry of Home Affairs vide Prime Minister's Office OMs No.RTI-5900/2013-PMR dated 20-11-2013 and No.RTI/5953/2013-PMR dated 21-11-2013, and further transferred by Under Secretary, RTI, Ministry of Home Affairs to the undersigned CPIO vide their OMs No.A-43020/01/2013-RTI dated 03-12-2013 and 9-12-2013. (Received on 10-12-2013 and 11-12-2013 respectively)

2. Regarding information sought under point No.1 & 2 of your RTI application, it is informed that the information sought by you is closely related to the State Govt. of Punjab. You may obtain the requisite information from the State Govt. of Punjab. However, as per records available with the undersigned CPIO, it is informed that the State of Punjab witnessed more than a decade of terrorist violence during the 80s and 90s. During this phase, 11694 number of civilians were killed by terrorists and 1784 number of security force personnel also suffered casualties. The religion wise segregation of deceased persons is not available in the records of undersigned CPIO.


3. Point No. 3 & 8 of your RTI application pertain to IS-II Division, Point 4 pertains to Judicial Division and points 5 to 7 pertain to Foreigners Division of this Ministry. 
