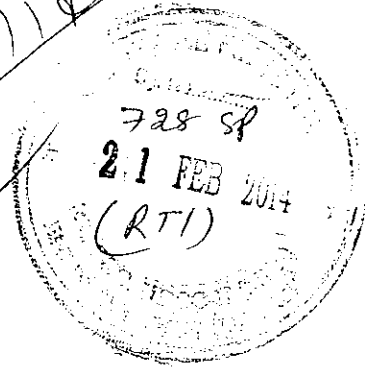

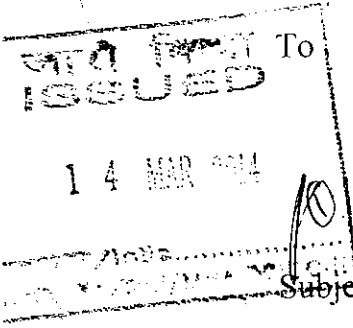



6.	From which date the family pension has to be commenced from the disbursing authority ? The guidelines are silent why ?	Pension can be transferred in the name of eligible dependent from the date following the date of death of the freedom fighter.
