However in such cases, the foreigners eligible for honorary work with the NGOs may be paid an honorarium upto a ceiling of Rs. 10,000 per month.
- 3. In case you are not satisfied with the information furnished, you may file an appeal before the Appellate Authority i.e. Shri V. Vumlunmang, Joint Secretary (Foreigners), Ministry of Home Affairs, NDCC-If Building, Jai Singh Road, New Delhi-110011 within the prescribed time limit.
