

2. With regard to information sought by you in point nos. 1 and 2 of your RTI application, the requisite information is given below:

Point no. 1 & 2 - The exempted cases are -

- (a) Senior citizens (those above 65 years of age)
- (b) A Pakistani national married to an Indian national; and
- (c) Children below 12 years of age accompanying parents(s) as given in (b) above.

  - (iii) Indian women married to Pak nationals and returning due to widowhood/divorce and having no male member to support them in Pakistan; and
  - (iv) Cases involving extreme compassion.
