

- 2. The matter was discussed with Director (RTI). As per Clause 6 (3) of Chapter II of the RTI Act, 2005, which states that where an application is made to a public authority requesting for an
 - (i) which is held by another public authority; or
 - (ii) the subject matter of which is more closely connected with the functions of another public authority.

the public authority, to which such application is made, shall transfer the application or such part of it as may be appropriate to that other public authority and inform the applicant immediately about such transfer.

- 3. There is no such provision which states that where more than two Divisions are involved, the information to be provided under the RTI Act would be dealt with by the Coordination Division.
- Coordination Division deals with various issues to provide information to the applicant but where the information does not relate to the Coordination Division, the concerned Territorial Division of the Ministry is requested to provide information directly to the applicant. This has been agreed by Director (RTI).

In view of the above, we may request CPV Division to provide information to the parts related to them and rest of the information can be provided by other concerned Territorial Divisions. This may be informed to the applicant when CPV Division sends information relating to them.

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



- 2. CPV Division has now raised the question that several Divisions are involved in providing information which Shri Tripathi has asked. SS (CPV)'s remarks may be seen on the enclosed note in which he has stated that Coordination Division should coordinate information and reply to the RTI applicant.
- 3. As per Clause 6 (3) of Chapter II of the RTI Act 2005, it is clearly mentioned that the receiving CPIO will send information directly to the applicant and information which does not relate to him may be requested from the concerned Divisions to provide information to the applicant directly.

4. Since the RTI application is of September 2012, it is requested that the subject matter may be dealt with by the CPV Division as well as the concerned Divisions and not by the Coordination Division. The matter was earlier discussed with Director (RTI).
