Sir,

Please refer to your RTI application dated 08.07.2014, received by the undersigned on 28.07.2014 on transfer from Director (F-II), Foreigners Division, Ministry of Home Affairs vide their Dy. No.3494/Dir (F-II)/14 dated 25/28.07.2014, seeking information under the RTI Act, 2005.

2. With regard to the information sought by you in the RTI application it may be stated that necessary inquiries are conducted when a foreigner is found to be in possession of an invalid travel documents or comes to adverse notice or overstays beyond the validity of visa. On completion of the inquiry and its consequent findings, the foreigner is either deported as per provisions of section 3(2)(c) of the Foreigners Act, 1946 or action is taken to book him/her under section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946. In all cases, where the foreigner is arrested and action is taken under the relevant Acts, the foreigner is deported/repatriated only after completion of the sentence/court proceedings.

3. In case you are not satisfied with the information furnished, you may file an appeal before the Appellate Authority i.e. Shri V. Vumlunmang, Joint Secretary (Foreigners), Ministry of Home Affairs, NDCC-II Building, Jai Singh Road, New Delhi-110011 within the prescribed time limit.
