**Subject:** Revised pay scales for Official Language posts in various subordinate offices of the Central Government.

Consequent upon the implementation of the recommendations of Sixth Central Pay Commission, this Department has received queries from many Ministries/Departments regarding the revised pay structure applicable in the case of Official Language posts existing in subordinate offices of the Central Government. In this connection, it is clarified that in accordance with the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission as accepted by the Government, similarly designated posts existing outside the Central Secretariat Official Language Service (CSOLS) cadre in various subordinate offices of the Central Government have been granted the same pay scales as those granted to CSOLS. The Government has notified the following revised pay structure for the Official language cadre belonging to CSOLS:-



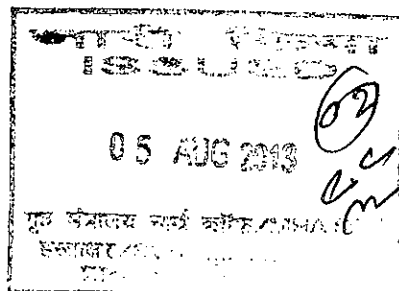

**Subject : Representation Of Shri Bharat Lal, Hindi Officer-grant of financial upgradation under the A.C.P. in the higher pay scale of Rs. 10,000-15,200/-**

**Reference : D.G., A.I.R., New Delhi I.D. Note No. 01/11/2008-S-VI, dated 17/04/2009/247 and subsequent reminder I.D. Note No. 01/11/2008-S-VI, dated 08/07/2009/594.**

It is pertinent to pin point that Official Languages Act (Rajbhasha Adhiniyam), 1963, as amended in 1967, has got nothing to do with recruitment to Hindi Posts in an organization of the Central Government.

It is also worth mentioning that according to the Press Release of January 29, 2009 (copy enclosed) regarding status of the employees of Prasar Bharati and the facilities to be extended to the employees of Prasar Bharati, "All Central Government employees, recruited for the purposes of working in Akashvani or Doordarshan, as on the 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 (i.e. the date on which the GOM on Prasar Bharati took a decision in this regard) on vacant government posts and recruited as per government rules, shall enjoy status equivalent to employees serving on "deemed deputation" as above from the date of their joining service under Akashvani and Doordarshan till the time of their retirement. They will be eligible for all facilities available to Central Government employees (including general pool accommodation, CGHS and Kendriya Vidyalaya) and all retirement and pensionary benefits also irrespective of whether Prasar Bharati is considered to be an Autonomous organization.

Thus, it is evident that the employees posted either to an Akashvani Kendra or to a Doordarshan Kendra/ Office as on October 05, 2007, are Central Government employees by all means, for all purposes and entitled to get all the benefits/ facilities available to other Central Government employees.

The Sixth Central Pay Commission vide para 7.19.68 of its Report has recommended the following pay structure for the Central Secretariat Official Language Service. :-

Further in the same paragraph, the Pay Commission has recommended the following :-

“A demand seeking identical pay scales has been made by similarly designated posts existing outside the CSOLS cadre in various subordinate offices. This demand will be automatically addressed once parity is given between field and secretariat offices. No separate recommendation is, therefore, necessary on this account.”

As per the Order passed by Smt. Madhulika P. Sukul, Joint Secretary (Personnel) and Appellate Authority, Department Of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance in the Case No. AA/65/2008 filed by Shri Ravi Aggarwal versus Central Public Information Officer, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance (copy enclosed), the Government has accepted the Report of the Sixth Central Pay Commission as a package subject to the modification contained in the Department of Expenditure Resolution No. 1/1/2008- IC dated 29.08.2008. Accordingly, all the similarly designated posts i.e. Hindi Posts existing outside the Central Secretariat Official Language Cadre in various subordinate offices are granted the same Pay structure as recommended for the personnel of the Central Secretariat Official Language Service. Ministry of Finance, Department Of Expenditure, Implementation Cell vide its Office Memorandum of November 24, 2008 (copy enclosed) and the Corrigendum of even number dated November 27, 2008 (copy enclosed) has clarified it reiteratedly that with effect from 01.01.2006, all the Ministries/ Departments etc. are required to grant the revised Pay Scales/ Pay Bands, and Grade Pay approved for various posts in the Central Secretariat Official Language Service to the similarly designated Official Language (Hindi) posts existing in their subordinate offices. The Government has approved the following Revised Pay Scale/ Pay Band and Grade Pay for various posts in the Central Secretariat Official Language Service which are also to be granted to the similarly designated Official Language (Hindi) posts in all the subordinate offices of different Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations :-

It is confirmed that the posts of Hindi Officer and those of the Assistant Director are quite identical and similarly designated ones. Similarly, the posts of the Hindi Translator and those of Jr. Translator/ Jr. Hindi Translator are also quite identical and similarly designated ones.

In view of the foregoing, the Hindi Officers working in different Akashvani Kendras/ Offices are to be granted pay in the Pay Band -3-Rs. 15600-39000 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5400 with effect from 01.01.2006 without any reluctance and reservation. Those Hindi Officers who had been granted financial upgradation under the pre modified Assured Career Progression Scheme in the next standard higher Pay Scale prior to 01.01.2006, are now to be granted pay in the Pay Band 3-Rs.15600-39100-with Grade Pay of Rs. 6600 i.e. just next higher Grade Pay with effect from 01.01.2006.


It has been gathered that only two Categories of Hindi posts exist in Akashvani Kendras / Offices i.e. Hindi Translators and Hindi Officers. The persons working as Hindi Translators in different Akashvani Kendras and Offices are to be granted pay in the Pay Band-2 i.e. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200 without any reluctance and reservation.

It is also note worthy that as per para 6.2 of the Annexure containing the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme for the Central Govt. Civilian Employees promulgated vide the Office Memorandum No.35034/3/2008-Estt.(D) of May 19,2009 (copy enclosed) issued by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (Deptt. of Personnel and Training) :

"In cases where financial upgradation had been granted to Government servants in the next higher scale in the hierarchy of their cadre as per the provisions of the ACP Scheme of August, 1999, but whereas as a result of the implementation of Sixth CPC's recommendations, the next higher post in the hierarchy of the cadre has been upgraded by granting a higher grade pay, the pay of such employees in the revised pay structure will be fixed with reference to the higher grade pay granted to the post. To illustrate, in the case of Jr. Engineer in CPWD, who was granted 1st ACP in his hierarchy to the grade of Asstt. Engineer in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 6500-10500 corresponding to the revised grade pay of Rs. 4200 in the pay band PB-2, he will now be granted grade pay of Rs.4600 in the pay band PB-2 consequent upon upgradation of the post of Asstt. Enggs. in CPWD by granting them the grade pay of Rs.4600 in PB-2 as a result of Sixth CPC's recommendation. However, from the date of implementation of the MACPS, all the financial upgradations under the Scheme should be done strictly in accordance with the hierarchy of grade pays in pay bands as notified vide CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008."

As such, those Hindi Translators of different Akashvani Kendras /Offices who had been granted financial upgradation under the pre modified Assured Career Progression Scheme in the pay scale of the next higher post in the hierarchy i.e. the pay scale of Hindi Officer prior to 01.01.2006 are now to be granted the Pay Band 3-Rs.15600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5400 with effect from 01.01.2006, upgraded Pay Band and Grade Pay approved by the Government for the next higher post of the Hindi Officers in the hierarchy without any reluctance and reservation, in view of the para No. 6.2, quoted above.





Subject: - Representation of Sh. Bharat Lal, Hindi Officer for grant of ACP in the higher scale of Rs. 10,000-15,200/-.

Sh. Bharat Lal was initially appointed as Hindi Officer in the pay scale of Rs. 6500-10,500/- and has been given up gradation to Rs. 7500-12,500/- on completion of 12 years of service in the grade. Whereas in other Departments the higher scale of Rs. 10,000-15,200/- has been given under the ACP Scheme.

In the above matter it may be mentioned that the ACP scheme provides for grant of next higher scale hierarchy subject to completion of other terms and conditions. In DG: AIR staff in the Hindi Section has been engaged on the scale of Rs. 6500-10,500/- and the next higher scale is Rs. 7500-12000/- apparently there is no promotional avenues and the appointments in Hindi Section are not as per provision in Rajbhasha Adhinyam. The official language set up is different from Hindi Translator and Hindi Officer being appointed by DG: AIR. Therefore, it is not feasible to accede to their demand. The copies of letters/orders provided by Sh. Bharat Lal, Hindi Officer are not relevant in this context. To make the matter more clear it may be mentioned that the Govt. of India has issued orders applicable to Official Language post in various subordinate offices of Govt. of India which relates to cadres in Official Language only and these posts are not included in the AIR Hindi set up.

In view of the above department of official language may clarify whether Hindi Officer working in DG AIR are eligible for grant of higher pay scale of Rs. 10,000-12500/- instead of Rs. 7500-12500/-.

Subject: - Representation of Sh. Bharat Lal, Hindi Officer for grant of ACP in the higher scale of Rs. 10,000-15,200/-.

Reference I.D. of even no. dated 17/04/2009 on the subject cited above.

In the matter it was mentioned that the ACP scheme provides for grant of next higher scale hierarchy subject to completion of other terms and conditions. In DG: AIR staff in the Hindi Section has been engaged on the scale of Rs. 6500-10,500/- and the next higher scale is Rs. 7500-12000/- apparently there is no promotional avenues and the appointments in Hindi Section are not as per provision in Rajbhasha Adhinyam. The official language set up is different from Hindi Translator and Hindi Officer being appointed by DG: AIR. Therefore, it is not feasible to accede to their demand. The copies of letters/orders provided by Sh. Bharat Lal, Hindi Officer are not relevant in this context. To make the matter more clear it may be mentioned that the Govt. of India has issued orders applicable to Official Language post in various subordinate offices of Govt. of India which relates to cadres in Official Language only and these posts are not included in the AIR Hindi set up.

In view of the above no response has been received so far, department of official language may clarify whether Hindi Officer working in DG: AIR are eligible for grant of higher pay scale of Rs. 10,000-12500/- instead of Rs. 7500-12500/-.
