Sir,

Please refer to your RTI application dated 05/07/2014 seeking information under RTI Act, 2005.

2. It is not clear from your application as to what "information" is required by you. However on perusal of your application it appears that your grievance is regarding recovery of TPT allowance Rs. 32592/- as per CISF letter No. F-18013/ACCTS/NFC/H/TPT/2014/1854 dated 04/04/2014.


3. Further, it is informed that as per Section-2 (j) of RTI Act, 2005, "right to information" means the right to information accessible under the Act which is held by or under the control of any public authority and includes the right to:

- (i) inspection work, documents, records;
- (ii) taking notes, extracts or certified copies of documents or records;
- (iii) taking certified sample of materials;
- (iv) obtaining information in the form of diskettes, floppies, tapes, video cassettes or in any other electronic mode or through printouts where such information is stored in a computer or in any other device.

In view of the above, it appears that the application submitted by you is not an application under RTI Act but it is a representation for keeping in abeyance recovery of TPT allowance Rs. 32592/- as per CISF letter No. F-18013/ACCTS/NFC/H/TPT/2014/1854 dated 04/04/2014. Hence, your grievance regarding recovery of TPT allowance does not fall in the ambit of RTI Act, 2005.

5. In case you are not satisfied with the reply, the appeal in the case lies with Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Joint Secretary (P-II), Room No. 171-B, MHA, North Block, New Delhi-01. The appeal may be filed within 30 days from the date of receipt of this reply.

RESPECTFULLY SUBMIT that The Petitioner has joined The CISE (Ministry of Home Affairs) as a regular sub-officer on 06th Oct. 1975 and commenced in this initial rank on completion of this Probation Period successfully under the Authority of DG/CISE No. G.O. 12/80 vide DG/CISE "ORDER" event No E-29020/69/806A-I dated 09th January 1981. Consequent upon attaining the age of "SUPERANNUATION" has been "RETIRED" from service on 31/01/2013

2) Because it is to inform you that Shri. N.K. Jha, Commandant (Local Rank) CISE Unit NFC, Hyderabad-69 as subject cited above declared Recovery for Rs. 32592/- in R/O JAI SINGH PARIMAR, Ex-Inspector as "Justified and Reasonable Cause" as because The Petitioner have not been provided Transport

Von duty as Transport i.e. Motor Cycle was seized by the "Commandant" as the Petitioner has no driving licence and deposited the motor cycle in the unit pool. I can not be taken in surprise that after a gap of one year and three months Recovery for Rs. 32592/- will be falling left to the gaps/Lapses on the part of Shri. N.K. Jha, Commandant (Local Rank) which amounts to discrimination and denial of Fundamental Rights to the Petitioner which is against the provision of CISE Service Regulation framed under Article 309 of The Constitution of India as mentioned in scheduled I, which sustain enquiry on the body, mind and reputation of The Petitioner.

3) Now Recovery for Rs. 32592/- in respect of The "Petitioner" does not survive and the Petitioner permission to file a writ (S) in The "Court of Law" against Shri N.K. Jha, Commandant (Local Rank) CISE Unit NFC, Hyderabad-69

4) So, I hope your sagacious attitude will look into the matter personally and considering "REQUEST" instant abeyance of Recovery for Rs. 32592/- on Petitioner till decision of Honble. Dy Secretary (PMA) & CPIO (Ministry of Home Affairs)
