2. J&K Division is concerned with part (1) of your RTI application. In this regard, it is stated that till 24th August, 2014, a total of 13893 civilians have been killed in terrorist violence in J&K. However, we do not maintain religion-wise/caste-wise records of civilians killed in terrorist violence. Further, it is stated that Relief is a State subject and ex-gratia amounts are sanctioned to the Next of Kins (NoKs) of civilian victims of terrorist violence as per the J&K Government's Relief Policy.


2. In this connection it is informed that since the subject matter of the information sought under part (1) of your RTI application pertains to J&K Division of this Ministry, your application is being transferred under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 to Shri R.P. Meena, Deputy Secretary (K-II) & CPIO, Ministry of Home Affairs, for necessary action.

3. The subject matter of the information sought under part (2) of your RTI application is more closely related to the State Govt. of Punjab, you may therefore obtain information from the State Govt. of Punjab under Section 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005. However, as per records available with the undersigned CPIO, the State of Punjab witnessed violence during the 80s and 90s. During this phase, 11694 civilians were killed by terrorists, 1784 security force personnel suffered casualties, and 8069 terrorists were killed by the security forces.

4. As regards the information sought under part (3 & 4) of your RTI application, the RTI Section has already transferred your RTI application to the Under Secretary (Delhi), Ministry of Home Affairs for appropriate action.

5. An appeal if any, against this reply, may be preferred within 30 days before Shri Rakesh Singh, Joint Secretary (IS-I) & Appellate Authority, Room No.197-B, Ministry of Home Affairs, North Block, New Delhi.

Please refer to your application dated 22/06/2014 under the RTI Act, 2005 which was received in this Ministry on 30/06/2014 by transfer from). It is mentioned in this regard that as per the RTI Act, 2005 & Right to Information (Regulation of Fee & Cost) Rules, a request for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of section 6 of RTI Act, 2005 shall be accompanied by an application fee of Rupees Ten by way of Cash against proper receipt or by Demand Draft or Bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order payable to the "Accounts Officer" of the public authority from where information is being sought.

2. The following deficiencies were observed in your above-referred RTI application:

i) The fee of Rs. 10/- has not been remitted, which is mandatory for all applicants other than those in the Below the Poverty Line (BPL) category.

ii) The fee has been remitted by way of Court Fee Stamp(s)/Non-Judicial Paper/Account Payee Cheque/Postage Stamp(s)/....., which is not a valid mode of payment of fee under the Act.

iii) The Demand Draft/Indian Postal Order has been furnished for an amount of Rs. 50/-, which is not the fee prescribed under the Act.

iv) The Demand Draft/Indian Postal Order furnished is not in favour of the correct authority. It should be payable to the "Accounts Officer, Ministry of Home Affairs".

3. In view of the above, your RTI application along with the IPO/Demand Draft/Cheque/Non-Judicial paper/Court Fee Stamp/..... (No. 77 G. 177312) for Rs. 50/- is returned in original.
