**Sub: Application under Right to Information Act, 2005.**

Please refer to your online RTI application dated 10.10.2013 (registration no. MHOME/R/2013/61374/1), which received in this section on 08.08.2014 as transferred by Mrs. Sulekha, Deputy Secretary (K-II) and CPIO, Ministry of Home Affairs vide letter dated 08-08-2014. The information pertaining to this section is as under:-

i) Due to onset of militancy in the State of Jammu & Kashmir in early 1990s, most of the Kashmiri Pandit families along with some families of Sikhs and Muslims migrated from Kashmir Valley to Jammu, Delhi and other places of the country. At present there are about 62000 registered Kashmiri migrant families in the country.

Jammu - **40,668** registered families (1.47 Lakh persons)  
Delhi - **19,338** registered families (57,000 persons)  
Other States - **1995** registered families (registration facility at Delhi)

ii) The district-wise details of the above Kashmiri migrant families registered at Jammu is enclosed at Annexure-I.

iii) PM's Package (2008) for the Return and Rehabilitation of Kashmiri Migrants: A package for Rs. 1618.40 Crore was announced by Hon'ble Prime Minister in 2008 to facilitate the return of the Kashmiri Migrants to the Valley, which provides for many comprehensive facilities for the migrants e.g. financial assistance for purchase/ construction of houses, repair/ renovation of damaged houses and dilapidated/ unused houses, construction of transit accommodation, Continuations of Cash relief to migrants, scholarship to students, Employment, Assistance for the Agriculture and the Horticulture, Waiver of interest on unpaid loan etc. All Kashmiri migrants, who migrated from the Kashmir Valley due to onset of militancy in the State of Jammu & Kashmir in early 1990s, are covered under this scheme.
