3. Information in respect of Naxal Management Division may be treated as 'Nil'.

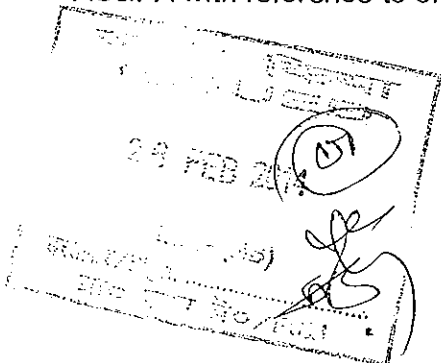
4. The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

**Omission of 'Satyameva Jayate' in the Mini Replicas of the State Emblem Used
on the Cars of Governors / Officers of Parliament / Judges / Constitutional Authorities**

Reference: MHA Office Memorandum No.13/1/2013-Public (Part-1) dated 12 June 2013

Respected Sir,

I am an ex-serviceman rendering fulltime Gandhian service to our nation. I have been dealing with the cases of Constitutional violations and Insults to National Honour. I represent public grievances to the authorities concerned.

I would like to humbly state that Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard and Border Security Force have rectified the error and made necessary amendments in their Flags / Logos by including 'Satyameva Jayate' in the State Emblem used by their forces. (copies of letters enclosed).

On my observation about the omission of 'Satyameva Jayate', the Rashtrapati Bhavan has made necessary corrections and included 'Satyameva Jayate' in the mini replica of the State Emblem used on the President's car. (Photos and copies of letters enclosed).

I have also sent a request to include 'Satyameva Jayate' in the mini replica used in the State Emblem of India on the car of the Governor of Tamil Nadu. (Photos and copies of letters enclosed)

Symbolising power, courage and confidence, the National Emblem of India is an old testimony proclaiming that truth alone triumphs. But country's official imprint borne by the cars of the authorities specified in the Schedule-1 of the State Emblem of India (Regulation of Use) Rules 2007 does not herald the same.

Hence I request your honour to issue necessary orders to include 'Satyameva Jayate' in the mini replicas of State Emblem of India used on the cars of the authorised dignitaries including Governors of all states and Union Territories, Officers of Parliament, Judges etc specified in the Schedule-1 of the State Emblem of India (Regulation of Use) Rules,2007.

This as a true citizen of India, I bring it to your kind notice to uphold the dignity of Nation Symbols.

I may be intimated by your secretariat about the action take in this regard. Jai Hind.
